



















Multiple User's Needs across Multiple Scales









## Summary

- Indigenous Knowledge relationships between components /asking different questions
- Year round monitoring / across seasons
- Unique knowledge and status in remote areas
- Equitable and meaningful engagement
- Sustainability of observation/monitoring initiatives

- Indigenous People's hold a unique knowledge and a holistic understanding of the Arctic which is needed in Arctic Observing Systems
